The total number of copies collected by type of material is 36,159 titles mostly composed of books, periodicals, theses and materials in electronic format. The highest number of materials gathered was the General Circulation books with a total number of 13,142. These are books written by foreign authors and published by foreign companies. The Filipiniana books follows in the ranking with a total of 5,160. These are materials written by Filipino authors and published by Filipino publishing companies. Periodical/Serials collections have a total of 4,765 published by foreign and Filipino companies. Most of these were back-issues and the current ones were donated as shown in table 2.

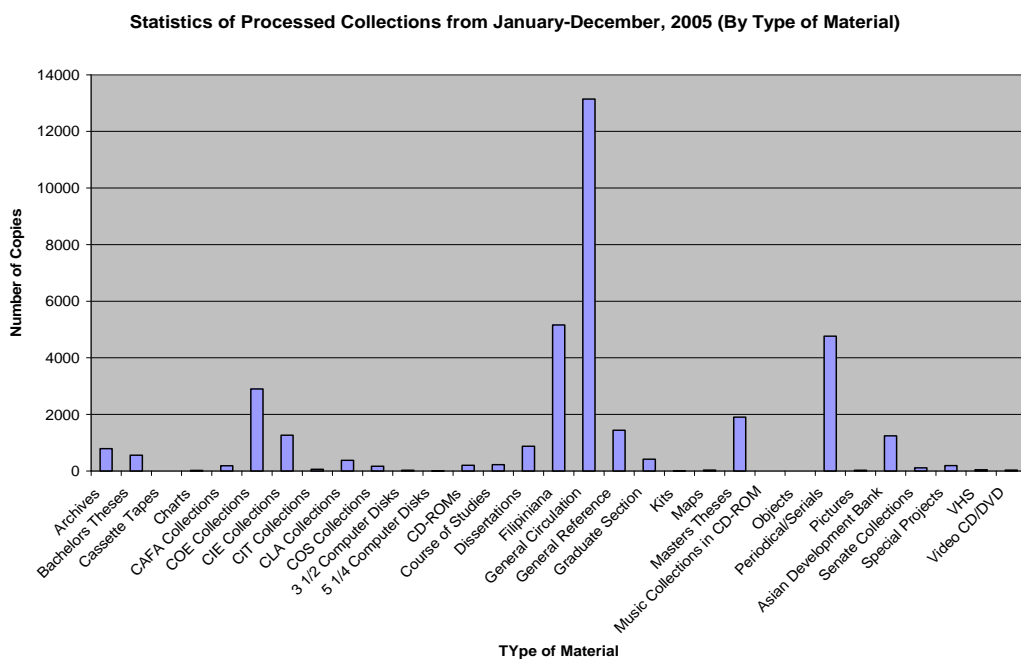

The fourth highest number of collections is the College of Engineering Learning Resource Center with a total number of 2,900. These are theses, books and periodicals. The Asian Development Bank collections have a total

number of 1,244 and the College of Industrial Education Learning Resource has 1,266. The library material that has a few number of copies are cassette tapes, music collections in CD-ROM and objects. The graph below show the comparison of number of copies for each type of collection.

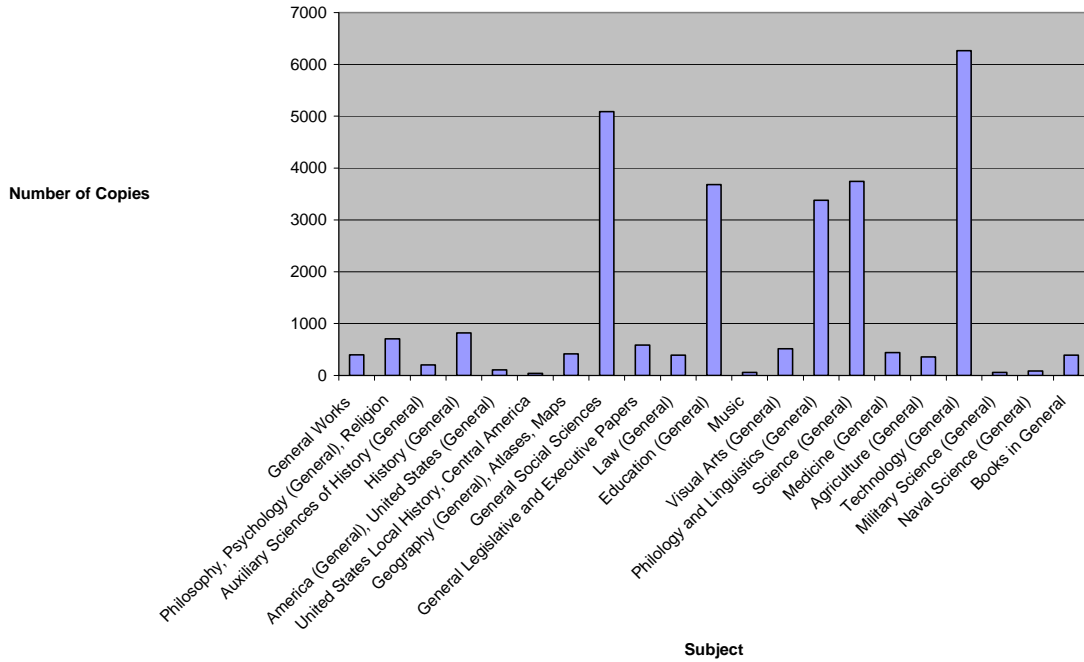

As shown in the table, there are 27,717 copies of library materials classified by the University Library. The highest number of copies is the technology materials with 6,264. These are books and periodicals written by foreign and Filipino authors as well as the materials in electronic format. The second highest is the general social sciences materials with a total of 5,091 copies. The third highest is the education materials with a total number of copies of 3,680. The fourth in ranking is the philology and linguistics materials with a total of 3,379. The lowest is the United States Local History, Central America materials with a total number of copies of 39. The graph below shows the ranking.

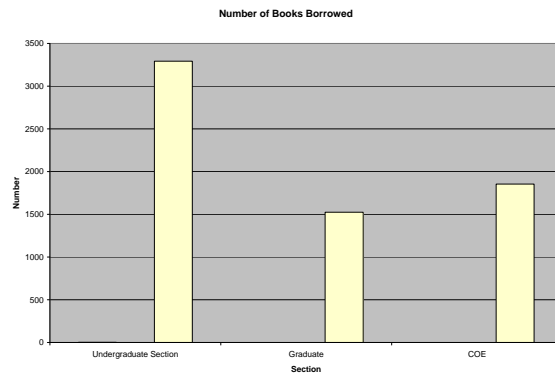

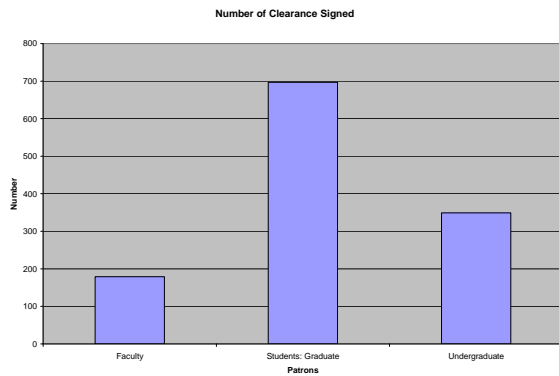
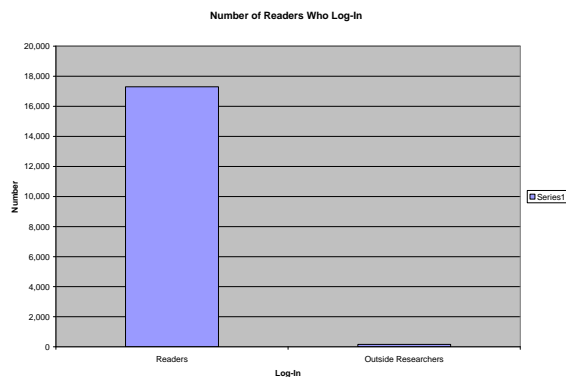

Research

The Development of an On-Line Digital Library System (OLDLS) for the Technological University of the Philippines – Manila Campus

The proponent developed an On-Line Digital Library System for TUP Manila. It provides a user-friendly platform that will cater all the digital and multimedia resources of the university in such a way that can be accessed on-line by clicking a link in the university URL (<http://www.tup.edu.ph>) and supplying a password. The On-Line Digital Library System is a program that maintains all the multimedia files such as electronic book, graphics, audio, video

and text files in a digital library server. These files could be uploaded from the Internet so that users can access them on-line. It provides a Graphical User Interface (GUI) that allows authorized users to search the digital library and do their researches anytime and anywhere they want. Its additional features are advance database utilities and maintenance specifically programmed for TUP library administrators. It has an advanced security module to maintain the integrity and reliability of data and an attendance module for effective monitoring of those who accessed the files. The system was tested and evaluated by 30 persons coming from 2 major groups: the library Patrons, and IT Administrators group. The patrons groups were composed of students coming from masteral degrees, bachelor's degree and technician courses both from TUP and other schools. The Library and IT administrators were also selected from TUP and other major universities in Manila. Based on the results of the evaluation, it was concluded that the objective of the study which were to provide user environment that allows library resources to be accessed through the Internet or Intranet, put together all the digitized data and multimedia resources of TUP Manila in a digital library server and allow students and researchers to search, browse and print them even if they are not within the university premises were achieved by the proponent. The overall mean of 4.84 with a descriptive evaluation of highly acceptable confirms that the objectives were met and that the resulting study surpassed the minimum requirement of a digital library system. Its implementation is highly recommended.
